## **MODERATE TO SEVERE PLAQUE PSORIASIS BIOLOGIC TREATMENT PATHWAY IN ADULTS**

Patients must be treated by a consultant dermatologist and the psoriasis must have failed to respond to standard systemic therapies including: ciclosporin, methotrexate and PUVA or the patient is intolerant as per <u>NICE CG 153 (updated Sept 17)</u>. Identify comorbidities (CV risk assessment). Offer / sign post to advice healthy lifestyle information, lipid modification, smoking cessation, weight management, increase in physical activity or treatment of depression in addition to offering medication. See overleaf for local resources.

The treatment options below are all approved to be used under certain criteria as set out by NICE. For some patients the choice of biologic will be driven by co-morbidities such as heart failure, demyelination, pregnancy & infection risk. If patients and their clinicians consider that there is a range of suitable options, the least expensive option should be chosen.
